

Family Feud Fun

Description:

Using the TV Family Feud game-show format, the participants are challenged to give the best answers to a series of questions.

Game Objective:

To have two "Families" compete in answering health questions. The family with the most points at the end of all the rounds is the successful family.

Materials Needed:

- ⇒ Stapler (staples removed)
- ⇒ Chalkboard
- ⇒ Chalk
- ⇒ Eraser
- ⇒ Challenge questions/Answer key

Directions:

1. Select a challenge question/answer key.
2. Draw the game board on the chalkboard for as many categories as necessary for the question, for example:

<u>Smiths</u>		<u>Browns</u>

Set-up for a seven answer questions

3. Divide the participants into two "families" --have them choose their own family name. Further divide the "families" into four groups representing the four family members.
4. Ask each family to send forward one member of group#1.
5. The two participants stand facing the teacher's desk with their arms at their sides.
6. Place the empty stapler an equal distance from the two opponents. (The stapler is used as a "buzzer.") The first player with a hand on the stapler gets to answer the question. Remind participants to use the flat part of their palm with their fingers fully extended to avoid pinching their fingers..
7. Ask a question preceded by the statement, "I surveyed a studio audience and got their best response to this..." For example, name a benefit of regular exercise.
