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Specialty Care Management Programs

Lead Care Management

Members are eligible for the Lead CM program when there is a positive blood lead test equal to or greater than five (5) micrograms per deciliter (elevated blood lead level, or EBL).

Sickle Cell Care Management

The Sickle Cell CM team provides support and oversight of coordination of efforts for Sickle Cell members, care givers and health care providers to meet the complete medical needs of members with an added focus on those members identified as complex or high utilizers.

General Pediatric & Adult Care Management

The [Pediatric & Adult Care Management](#) staff assist members in achieving optimum health, functional capability, and quality of life through improved management of their disease or condition. They work collaboratively with members, family and significant others, providers, and community organizations to develop goals and assist members in achieving those goals.

Start Smart for Your Baby

[Start Smart for Your Baby®](#) is our special program for individuals who are pregnant. In addition, we have a focused program specifically designed for pregnant people with substance use disorder.

For babies requiring NICU stays, we also offer **NICU Care Management**. A dedicated NICU care manager assists with communicating with the baby's medical team, understanding the baby's plan for care, helping to find additional health care resources if needed, and more.

Behavioral Health Care Management

The intent of Behavioral Health Care Management is to provide individualized, strength-based, holistic care to members identified for services. HSH recognizes that best practice approaches the promotion of mental health as part of the larger field of health promotion. Mental health is not just the absence of illness but is the promotion of well-being and healthy behaviors.

The care managers are trained to support FUH visits to help meet NCQA HEDIS measure: percentage of members received follow-up within 7 or 30 days of discharge.

Asthma Waves Program

The [asthma program](#) provides a designated asthma care manager who will provide telephonic or face-to-face interaction, education and support services to promote adherence to asthma treatment guidelines, prevent exacerbations and optimize functional status, and referrals.

Spacer, peak flow meter, and hypoallergenic items can be sent directly to the member's home without requiring a prior auth or a prescription. Members receive \$25 My Health Pays rewards if 3 coaching sessions are completed.

Show Me Healthy Kids

Coverage under [Show Me Healthy Kids \(SMHK\)](#) managed by Home State Health began July 1, 2022. Individuals who qualify for coverage through SMHK were automatically moved to this plan from their existing health plan or will be enrolled in this health plan the day they are approved for MO HealthNet benefits. They will continue to get their healthcare coverage through this plan as long as they are eligible. Eligibility groups for SMHK include:

- Children in the care and custody of the Missouri Department of Social Services
- Children receiving adoption or legal guardianship subsidy
- Adults under the age of 26, who were in foster care on their 18th birthday and covered by MO HealthNet, and who meet other eligibility criteria
- Former foster care youth under the age of 26, who were previously in foster care on their 18th birthday and covered by Medicaid from another state, and who are not currently eligible for Medicaid coverage under another program

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Asthma Waves Program



An Asthma program providing telephonic/Virtual education and support services by our dedicated Care Manager and team. The goal is to promote adherence to asthma treatment guidelines, prevent exacerbations, optimize functional status, and provide referrals to community resources.

Who is eligible?

- ADD/ADHD diagnosis
- Take a prescribed medication for ADD/ADHD
- Be between 4-12 years of age
- Be enrolled in care management

This Kit can be used as a therapeutic tool for members to help with concentration and/or sooth self-stimulating behaviors.

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Meal Benefits

Members who recently delivered a baby and has been released from an inpatient stay are eligible for meals.

Members who meet criteria for our pregnancy pilot program based upon the criteria below are also eligible for meals:



Pregnant Members

Members must meet the following criteria:

- Member is actively engaged with SSFB Care Management
- Member is pregnant and between 20-32 weeks gestation.
- Identify as having a food insecurity as identified in the OB Screen, OB Care Management Assessment, Trimester Assessments or Comprehensive Member Assessment
- Enrolled in WIC services
- Have a history of or one of the following conditions:
 - Hypertension or preeclampsia
 - Diabetes or gestational diabetes

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Meal Benefits

Members who live alone and have inadequate caregiver support at home or are unable to prepare or access food due to their physical health conditions may be eligible.

Members who meet criteria for our chronic condition pilot programs below are also eligible for meals:



Chronic Disease Management- Adult Member

Members can qualify for up to 12 weeks of meals.

Members must meet the following criteria:

- Identify as having a food insecurity
- 18 years of age or older
- Have one of the following conditions:
 - Hypertension
 - Diabetes
 - Obesity

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Telemonitoring for Hypertension and Diabetes

Program supporting members with Hypertension and Diabetes. Members engaged in this program will receive Bluetooth enabled devices, either glucose monitor or blood pressure cuff. Members engaged receive the following:

- Welcome Kit
- Clinical support and compliance outreach
- DM supplies sent directly to member's door when member is compliant with checking his/her blood sugars.



HiSET Exam Voucher Program is available to members over the age of 16 who have education-related goals in their care plan. Members will receive one (1) HiSET Exam Voucher (which includes all five (5) tests) per year

MARC Program: Health promotion courses that are 6 week, small-group classes that support chronic health conditions, develop healthy eating habits, and developing action plans to enhance the quality of life.



Weight Watchers: Members with a BMI greater than 25 and is engaged with disease or care management is eligible for the program. Members can select in-person or 14 weeks of online tools/classes.

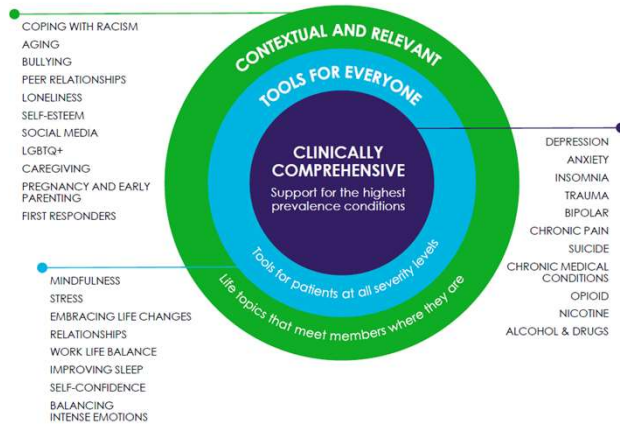

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Dental and Vision Benefits

Vision

All members through age 25, pregnant, or have blindness:

- One comprehensive eye exam or one limited eye exam per calendar year
- One pair of eye glasses every 2 calendar years.
 - Frames must be sturdy and of good quality
 - Special frames will be covered only when considered medically indicated as defined by MO Healthnet
 - A member may request a more expensive frame than provided under the MO Healthnet program but would be responsible for the cost associated with the more expensive frame.
 - Replacement of eyewear is a benefit when glasses are necessary for school.

<p>Tobacco-Free Counseling. Completion of 2 smoking cessation counseling sessions per calendar year either by enrolling in our Disease Management program and completing them with a Health Advisor OR completing them with assigned primary care doctor (eligible ages 18+).</p>
<p>Behavioral Health (BH) Follow Up Visit. Completion of a follow up doctor visit within 30 days of being discharged from a behavioral health related inpatient admission (eligible ages 6+).</p>
<p>Annual Breast Cancer Screening Completion of at least one screening per calendar year (eligible ages 40-74).</p>
<p>Annual Chlamydia Screening. Completion of chlamydia screening once per calendar year (eligible ages, 16-24).</p>
<p>Cervical Cancer Screening. Completion of one screening within a 3-year period (eligible ages, 21-64).</p>

Well Care Visit with Assigned Primary Care Doctor. Must complete visit within 90 days of enrollment.

Annual Well Care Visit. Complete annual Well Care Visit with assigned primary care doctor (eligible for ages 2+).

Telehealth Visit. Completion of one telehealth visit per calendar year.

Lead Screening. Completion of lead screening test before members' 2nd birthday. (Can only earn this reward once per lifetime).

Annual Dental Visit. Complete annual dental visit once per calendar year (eligible ages 2-21).

Health Coaching Calls. Completion of at least 3 health coaching calls (per calendar year). To be eligible, member must be enrolled in Care Management with a diagnosis of asthma, depression, diabetes, or pediatric obesity.

KEEPING KIDS HEALTHY

Children do not need to be sick to see a doctor. Your child should have a well-child checkup every year. The doctor will make sure your child is healthy and up to date on immunizations (shots). Immunizations help protect children from diseases like polio and measles. Young children may need to be checked for lead exposure. Lead exposure can cause learning and behavior problems.

Is your child a teenager? He or she will need an adolescent health check. This may include a screening for depression. The doctor may ask about risks teenagers may take, like using drugs.

OTHER BENEFITS AND PROGRAMS

Enhanced & Same Day Transportation

Same day transportation is available for visits to your Primary Care Physician (PCP), OB/GYN for pregnant members, and for 7-day Behavioral Health visits after a hospital stay.

Transportation is also available for family visits, court appointments, child welfare-related meetings, WIC appointments, and social determinants of health-related supports, such as to food banks, employment services, job interviews, and housing-related meetings. (For members eligible to receive non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit).

If you recently delivered a baby and were released from the hospital OR are unable to make or get food because of a health condition, you may be eligible to receive up to 30 days of meals from Mom's Meals.

Pregnant moms enrolled in Care Management are eligible to receive a maternity abdominal support band. These bands help support your waist, hip and lower back.

Weight Watchers

A program that works towards better eating and lifestyle habits. Members must meet program requirements to participate.

Digital Care Management

An application (app) that connects you with your Home State Health or Show Me Healthy Kids care management team for support. You will have access to articles and videos, the ability to set reminders for appointments, medications, & exercise, and can communicate directly with your care manager via the digital platform.

ConnectionsPlus Phone Program:

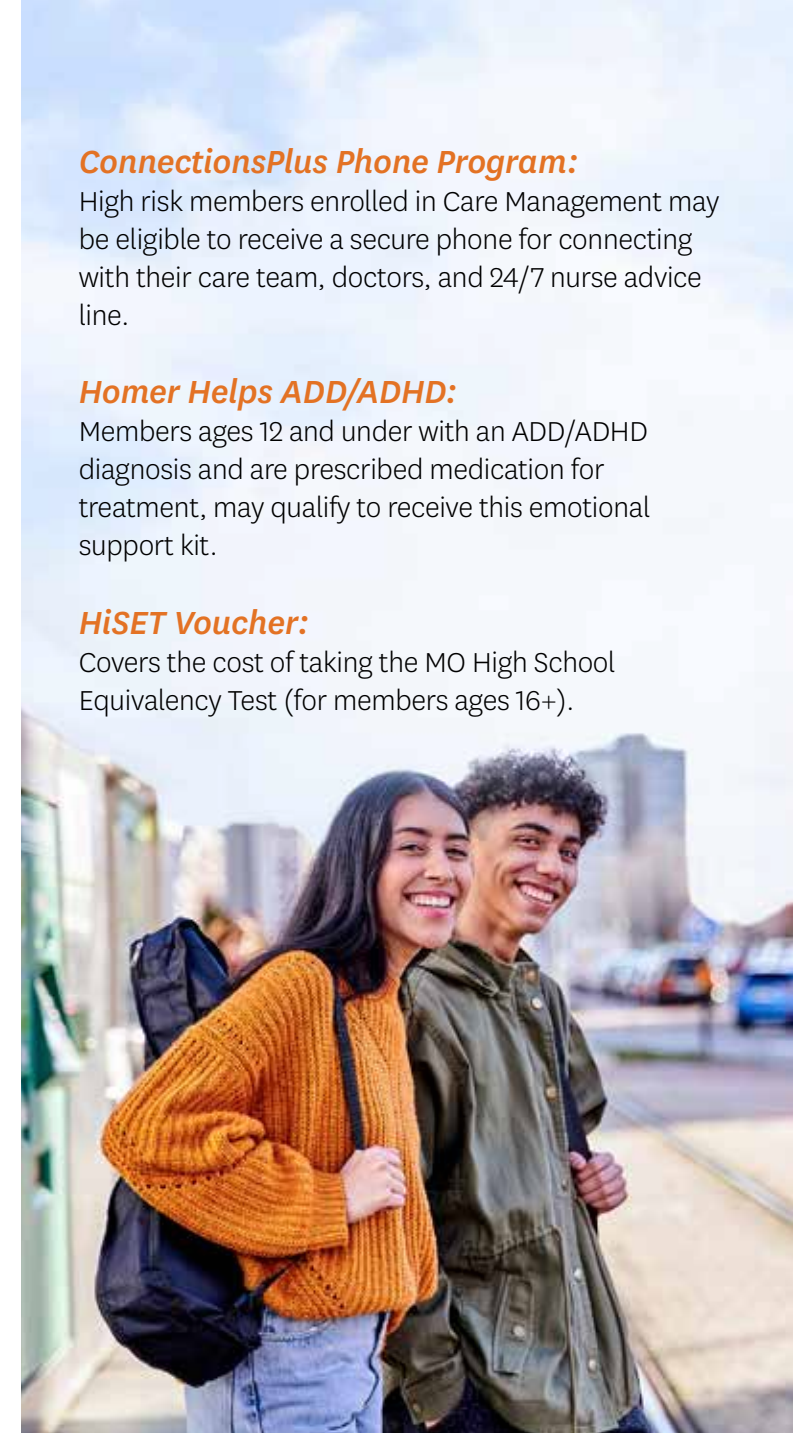
High risk members enrolled in Care Management may be eligible to receive a secure phone for connecting with their care team, doctors, and 24/7 nurse advice line.

Homer Helps ADD/ADHD:

Members ages 12 and under with an ADD/ADHD diagnosis and are prescribed medication for treatment, may qualify to receive this emotional support kit.

HiSET Voucher:
